



NOTICE OF RACE

2008 I-LYA Travelers Series
JUNIOR Regatta
August 2nd, 2008
Jolly Roger Sailing Club, Toledo, Ohio



1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by 'rules' as defined by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the Laser, Laser Radial, Club Flying Junior, Club 420, and Thistle classes, (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions), this Notice of Race and by the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 ALCOHOL & DRUGS

Per US SAILING Regulation 5.03, no competitor shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, and distilled spirits) or use any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.), the possession of which is unlawful. This regulation is in effect during the entire event, from date and time of arrival through date and time of departure.

On report of a violation of this regulation, a hearing will be held generally in accord with the recommendations of Appendix L of the RRS. Penalties for a violation of the regulation may range from a reprimand to dismissal from the regatta. Additionally, further action under rule 69 may be recommended by the hearing officers.

The officers for hearing a violation of US SAILING Regulation 5.03 will consist of the Chief Judge, acting as chairman of the hearing, the jury, and the Event Chairman.

2 ALTERATIONS OF CLASS RULES

The class rules will be used except that RRS 60.1 (a) is changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for an alleged breach of a class rule requiring class membership or imposing a weight limit.

3 ADVERTISING

Advertising is in accordance with the ISAF Advertising Code (Appendix 1) and the relevant class rules.

4 CLASSES

Boat class Optimist with crew of one including helmsman, will be used.

Boat class Laser Radial with crew of one including helmsman, will be used.

Boat class Laser with crew of one including helmsman, will be used.

Boat class Club Flying Junior with crew of two including helmsman, will be used.

Boat class Club 420 with crew of two including helmsman, will be used.

Boat class Thistle with crew of three including helmsman, will be used.

5 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

5.1 AGE

Applicants for all classes must not turn 19 years old by Jan 1, 2009. Optimist class age rules apply.

5.2 Traveler's Series

The Regatta is a counter in the **I-LYA Traveler Series**.

6 APPLICATION

Application shall be made by completing the entry form and returning it with one check (or cash) for the entry fee payable to Jolly Roger Sailing Club. Entry deadline is 10:00, August 2nd.

7 FEES

The entry fee for all classes is \$15.00 per competitor. The entry fee includes breakfast, water on the course, and onshore lunch. The entry fee, payable to Jolly Roger's Sailing Club, must be included with the entry form. Entry fee is refundable.

8 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

1000 Skipper's Meeting, registration closed.

1100 First race of the day, of five races scheduled

1600 Awards presentation

No race shall be started after 14:00.

9 MEASUREMENT

Each competitor will be responsible for their boats being in compliance with the class rules.

10 SCORING

The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the racing rules, will apply for all classes. A maximum of seven races are scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series. If five or more races are sailed, a boat's worst score shall be discarded.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to competitors placing first through third in all divisions.

12 SAFETY

A Coast Guard-approved PFD must be worn and fully secured at all times while afloat, except for brief periods while adding or removing clothing. Whistles permanently attached to the PFDs are recommended. This amends rule 40.
